You'd have to be living under a rock if you haven't heard by now that [Cleveland Play House](#) (CPH) is the recipient of the [2015 Regional Theatre Tony Award](#). Just in time for CPH's 100th Anniversary, this award is based on the recommendation of the American Theatre Critics Association.

How is CPH Managing Director **Kevin Moore** reacting to the huge honor?

"My first reaction was, well, I got a bit teary-eyed to be honest. The artists and staff of CPH have worked so hard for so long, and this community has been so generous, well it's just a bit overwhelming," says Moore.

Celebrating the achievement along with Artistic Director **Laura Kepley**, the CPH Board, staff and all of Cleveland, Moore says he and Kepley "will definitely be at the Tony's, as will Board Chair Alec Pendleton. We're trying to figure out tickets to see if some others can join us." It's easy to say that many in Northeast Ohio will be tuning in to the celebration this year, as well.

The 100th season is a big one, with a lineup that features "Ken Ludwig's A Comedy of Tenors," Arthur Miller's "The Crucible," the holiday favorite "A Christmas Story," monster musical "Little Shop of Horrors," Katori Hall's "The Mountaintop," Rebecca Gilman's "Luna Gale," Cleveland native Rajiv Joseph's "Mr. Wolf," and the popular southern-drenched "Steel Magnolias."

"This Tony is for a century full of people, and we hope that every one of them feels the pride and joy of the moment. It is also a springboard into our next 100 years as we seek to live up to this high honor," says Moore.
